







### Site Narrative:

The Gardner Asphalt site is located 3151 Fiberglass Road in the Fairfax District of Kansas City, Kansas. The Fiberglass Road site was initially identified after an environmental audit and Pre-Acquisition Investigation was conducted at 3155 Fiberglass Road (Former Olin Water Services Facility) in November 1989. Chlorinated hydrocarbons, including TCE and cis 1,2-DCE, were detected in ground water. A Screening Site Inspection (SSI) completed by KDHE in April 1995 at 3155 Fiberglass Road and concluded that there is a likely source for chlorinated hydrocarbons detected in ground water at the Former Olin Water Services facility (a.k.a. - Ashland/Olin site) with the property at 3151 Fiberglass Road likely contributing to ground water contamination as well. In 1997, the Olin Corporation signed a Consent Order with KDHE to assess releases at the 3155 Fiberglass Road site; the Fiberglass Road site was renamed the Ashland/Olin site.

In May 2008, a Preliminary Assessment (PA) performed at the Gardner Asphalt site by KDHE recommended further assessment at the site in the form of a Site Inspection (SI). Laboratory results indicate that the TCE concentration in ground water at the site exceeds its RSK value. Detection of TCE in soil at the site indicates there are likely source areas located on the property at 3151 Fiberglass Road. The ground water pathway appears to pose the most significant threat from the site, although no drinking water wells are known to be contaminated with TCE.

The current property owner submitted an application in Apr 2012 to address the site in the VCPRP. VA 12VCP0012 was
